### LEAD Center TA includes:

- Developing tailored strategies to meet the unique needs of job seekers with disabilities when delivering Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) programs
- Embedding mental health supports and disability accommodations into services
- Supporting cross-agency collaboration to align funding and coordinate services
- Strengthening state-level data sharing to better support disabled job seekers
- Designing career pathways, including Registered Apprenticeship Programs, for direct support professionals
- Advancing self-employment models for people with disabilities
- Promoting financial literacy and benefits planning to support economic empowerment for people with disabilities

- Partnering with systems such as Medicaid, vocational rehabilitation, behavioral health, and education to integrate work incentives and employment supports
